

SEC. 10-1-11 SPEED LIMITS.

- a) State Speed Limits Adopted. The provisions of Sections 346.57, 346.58,, and 346.59, Wis. Stats., relating to the maximum and minimum speed of vehicles are hereby adopted as part of this Section as is fully set forth herein, except as specified by this Section pursuant to Sec. 349.11(3)(c), Wis. Stats., where the Common Council has determined that the statutory speed limits are unreasonable, unsafe and imprudent and has modified such limits.
- b) Speed Limits Increased or Established. The speed limits are increased or established as hereinafter set forth in this Subsection upon the following streets or portions there of between the limits designated:

(1) Alleys. Fifteen (15) miles per hour in any alley.

(2) Residential Zones. Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on all City streets except as indicated in Subsection (1) and (3) of this Section.

(3) U.S. Highway 141, City of Niagara, Marinette County, Wisconsin:

- a) Thirty-five (35) miles per hour from the north corporate limits of the City of Niagara, southerly to a point 0.06 of a mile north of Coolidge Avenue;
- b) Thirty (30) miles per hour from a point 0.06 of a mile north of Coolidge Avenue in the City of Niagara, southerly to a point 0.09 of a mile north of Dewey Street;
- c) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour from a point 0.09 of a mile north of Dewey Street southerly to the corporate limits of the City of Niagara.
