

MINUTES

The annual meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by City Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Audrey Fredrick. Present: Mayor Joe Johnston; Alderpersons Mike Darne, Dan Decker, Lisa Johnson, Karl Lamoreaux, Glenn Lantagne, and Don Shampo; Police Chief Mike Chapman, Public Works Supervisor Jim Stachowicz

Also Present: Kyle Johnson and Thad Majkowski of Cedar Corporation, Lynn McIntyre of Cedar Corporation (via Teams Application)

City Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Fredrick administered the Oath of Office to Alderpersons Decker, Johnston and Lantagne.

A motion was made by Alderperson Decker and seconded by Alderperson Lantagne to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Alderperson Darne moved to elect Alderperson Johnson as the President of the City Council. Alderperson Shampo seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderperson Decker to approve the Boards, Commissions and Committees list with additions or changes noted. Alderperson Johnson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderperson Lamoreaux to approved the Standing Committee List for Approval. Alderperson Shampo seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderperson Lantagne to designate the Borderland Journal/Florence Mining News as the official newspaper of the City. The Iron Mountain Daily News was designated as an alternate. Alderperson Darne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderperson Decker to provide a monthly stipend of \$100.00 to the Mayor for supplies and mileage. Alderperson Darne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderperson Shampo moved to provide a monthly stipend of \$50.00 to the City Council President for supplies and mileage. Alderperson Lamoreaux seconded the motion. Alderperson Lantagne opposed the motion. A roll call vote was taken with Alderperson Lantagne voting "NAY", and all others voting 'AYE" Alderperson Decker abstained from voting. Motion carried on a vote of 4 "AYE" and 1 "NAY".

A motion was made by Alderperson Johnson to set the City Council meetings on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 5:00 p.m. until April 2027, unless scheduling changes were necessary. Alderperson Decker seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Alderperson Shampo and seconded by Alderperson Johnson to adjourn. Motion carried.
